MC UofL ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

To utilize MC benefits at UofL, students must meet one of the following criteria:

- Cumulative 3.3 HS GPA (GED 660), no ACT/SAT test score required.
- Cumulative 3.0 HS GPA or greater (GED 600) AND a 21 ACT/1060 SAT composite or Superscore.
- 60 transferable college credit hours or an associate degree.

Students who do not meet one of the criteria listed above have the following options:

- Participate in MC at JCTC until they earn 60 credit hours or an associate degree, then transfer to UofL.
- Utilize UPS Earn and Learn benefits, then petition after obtaining a 2.7 GPA at UofL. (<u>upsjobsky.com/ups-earn-and-learn</u>)
- Submit petition requesting approval to receive benefits. (forms.metro-college.com/petition)
