MC UofL ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

To utilize MC benefits at UofL, students must meet one of the following criteria:

- Cumulative 3.3 HS GPA (GED 660); no ACT/SAT test score required.
- Cumulative 3.0 HS GPA or greater (GED 600) AND a 21 ACT/1060 SAT composite or Superscore.
- 60 earned or transferable college credit hours or an associate degree.

Students who do not meet one of the criteria listed above have the following options:

- Participate in MC at JCTC until they earn 60 credit hours or an associate degree, then transfer to UofL.
- Utilize UPS Earn and Learn benefits, then petition after obtaining a 2.7 GPA at UofL. (upsjobsky.com/ups-earn-and-learn)
- Submit petition requesting approval to receive benefits. (forms.metro-college.com/petition)

CAPP REQUIREMENTS

1. Before first agreement: Student Transition Program
2. Before second agreement: High 5 Budgeting
3. 30 credit hours: Resume

REACH ACADEMIC COACH (UofL only)

Two appointments are required in semester of first UofL agreement. Students schedule at reach.louisville.edu/#coaching, selecting "Metropolitan College" as the Coaching Topic. Coaches identify learning strengths, develop plans, and promote self-confidence.

4. 60 credit hours: Experiential Learning (Modules A & B)
5. 90 credit hours: Mock Interview
6. Graduation surveys: 1-2 semesters before graduating
