PROGRAM DETAILS



This program provides a seamless pathway for students to obtain an Automotive Technician certification with an optional Associate in Applied Science degree while receiving 100% paid tuition and employment at both UPS and a local automotive dealership through Metropolitan College (MC).

Program eligibility:

- Pursuing a diploma or certificate need a 16 ACT or higher
- Pursuing an Associate of Science need to meet regular JCTC admission criteria of 16 ACT or higher
- Must meet UPS hiring requirements
- Must meet dealership hiring requirements (requirements vary by dealership)

METRO COLLEGE BENEFITS

- 100% JCTC tuition deferred*
- \$500 bonus each fall and spring semester with successful completion of 6 or more credit hours and no withdrawals, incompletes, failures or grades of D
- Fee payment assistance up to \$250 each fall and spring semester
- Customized career coaching

UPS EMPLOYMENT BENEFITS

- Starting pay rate \$21 per hour
- Receive health, dental, vision, prescription, and life insurance coverage after 9 months of employment

- 401K Contributions

AUTOMOTIVE DEALERSHIP BENEFITS

- Starting pay rate is set by the individual dealership
- Work 5 to 10 hours per week
- Tools provided (Tool purchasing programs available as you progress in the program)
- Upon completion of program student will be Level 1 Certified
- Opportunity to advance additional certifications at dealership

ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Step 1: Learn about the Automotive Technician Career Pathway

Step 2: Apply to JCTC and file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

- Apply to JCTC: https://jefferson.kctcs.edu/admissions
- File the FAFSA: https://studentaid.gov with JCTC's School Code: 006961
- After you have received your acceptance notice from JCTC, email JCTC Automotive Technician Program Coordinator Stephen Frame (stephen.frame@kctcs.edu) to help get registered for courses in this program - Let Stephen know you're a perspective Metro College student and will need a schedule that fits the recommendations for this pathway

Step 3: Apply and get hired at UPS as a 1DA Warehouse Worker (Air Handler)

- Apply at https://upsjobs.com/worldport Click Apply Now
- Must work in a 1DA HUB position (ramp positions will not work with this pathway)
- Apply 30-45 days prior to desired start date If "Warehouse Worker-Air Handler" is not available, please check back

Step 4: Submit a MC Automotive Technician Interest Form: https://tinyurl.com/3nve2smz

- Once you have a biometrics appointment at UPS, immediately submit form
- Submitting this form start the process of coordinating with UPS to identify employment in a work that starts approximately at 11PM - Employment in an 11PM work area is not guaranteed; every effort will be made to accommodate employment for this pathway
- Applicants will receive dealership information to set up interviews
- Applicants will interview with dealerships

Step 5: Submit the MC Automotive Technician Roster Form: https://tinyurl.com/vew6n3tz

- Submit after you have accepted employment at UPS and enrolled in coursework at JCTC
- This form initiates the process of having JCTC faculty identify a potential dealership match for you
- Accept position at dealership
